Minia University strives to achieve academic excellence and global competitiveness through high-quality education, innovative research, and impactful community development, while fostering strong partnerships with industry and society.








Minia University's Mission

- Minia University acts as a catalyst for social mobility and cultural preservation, reinforcing its role as both an academic institution and a driver of national progress.






- The establishment of Minia National University represents a valuable addition that enhances the role and reputation of Minia University.
