First – Vision :

Part II The system of study and evaluation of students

Article (5) Conditions of registration of the student to study in the bachelor's degree in physical education: a - be a holder of secondary school in the year of acceptance.

B - Pass the acceptance tests as determined by the Coordination Office.

C- The student must pass the medical examination in the area specified by Minia University in accordance with the decision of the College Council of the necessary examinations to enter the college.

D - be full-time full-fledged study at the college.

Article (6) Study System:

The duration of the study for a bachelor's degree in Physical Education is four years of university (8 semesters) and the duration of each semester is fifteen weeks. The study is theoretical, practical and practical.

The study in the bachelor's degree is divided into two phases as follows:

A - Basic stage:

It is a general study stage for all students of three years (6 semesters) in which the student studies the basic courses necessary and qualified to work in sports institutions and institutions of physical education for different stages of education.

B - Specialized stage:

This is a specialized study stage for students of the fourth year, two semesters in which the student studies according to the specialized fields shown in the following table in addition to what is developed from sports

Article (7) Course content:

The College Council shall approve the scientific content of each course after the approval of the relevant department council. The tables attached to this regulation shall explain the study plan and the syllabus distributed to the study teams, the number of hours of theoretical and practical lectures, the grades of the work of the year for the semester, Of theoretical material only).

Article (8): Distributing students

A- The fourth year students shall be distributed to the departments of the College in accordance with the percentages determined by the College Council for each department

B- The total number of grades of the third division and the total number of courses for each department determined by the College Council shall be taken into account and according to the students' wishes to choose the department at the level of differentiation.

C- Excludes students who excel in sports, where they can join the practical sections of the outstanding sports and have won international tournaments or the level of the Republic or the Egyptian universities.

Article (9): Academic Camps

The camps aim to train the student on how to organize the camps outside. These camps allow the students to participate in the preparation, organization and leadership of the camp as well as to participate in solving the problems that may arise in the camp as well as the educational program in which the students participate.

The student must attend two semesters during the course of his / her studies • within the basic requirements for obtaining a bachelor's degree, provided that the camp is held during the half-year vacation or summer vacation. Each camp has an educational program of at least 20 hours of study, with the responsibility of preparing and organizing these camps, sports administration and sports recreation

College, with the help of faculty members and their assistants in college. •

The College Council is responsible for determining the supervision • committee for these camps.

Article (10) Grade Grade Assessment:

A - Theoretical Courses:

The grade for the student is as follows:

for the final written examination of the Great End. %٧٠

The student is successful in the case of obtaining (50%) of the degree of the end of the bone tape to get (30%) at least the degree of the written examination or else considered a failure in this article.

B. Applied Courses:

The grade for the student is as follows:

In order to succeed in the course, the student must obtain (50%) of the maximum score of the exam. He must obtain at least 30% in both the written test and the applied test separately, otherwise the student will be considered a student.

C) Practical Courses: (Field Training)

The grade for the student is as follows:

of the work of the year of the Great End. %٥٠

for the practical exam of the Great End. %٥٠

The student must pass 60% of the final grade.

The article is extended and divided into two semesters as follows:

of the work of the year of the first semester great end %٢٥

for the final application test of the Great End %٢٥

of the work of the year of the second semester great end %٢٥

for the final application test of the second semester %٢٥

The following shall be applied:

A student of the third and fourth grades is considered to be a repeat student if he fails in the field training course at the end of the year, even if he is successful in all other courses.

B) The College Council shall determine the controls for the final examination in the field training of the fourth division for each field in the light of the proposals of the relevant department councils.

The College Council shall determine the method of implementation and supervision of the internal field training of the 3rd Division

The light of the proposals of the Department of Curriculum and Methods of Teaching Physical Education.

D- The College Council shall determine, according to the proposal of the relevant department council, the field training system for students under the supervision of the faculty members and the experts in this field through a field training office for each donor department. There are two types of field training.

The internal field training for students of the third and outer division of the fourth year students shall be training in the following bodies and institutions:

Clubs, youth centers, clubs, sports clubs, private schools, universities, tourist villages, recreational establishments, clubs, youth centers, The House of the Elderly - Schools of Intellectual Education - Schools of Light and Hope - or what the College Council considers by type of activity.

Article 11 Attendance:

A bachelor's degree examination shall be held in the courses that the student has studied in his / her department. The student must pass an exam for any course that meets the attendance ratio of not less than (75%). The course or the courses in which the attendance rate is not met after giving at least two warnings to the student. In this case, the student is considered to have failed in the courses in which he was prevented from taking the exam. If the student presents an excuse for not attending the semester exam,

The Committee for Education and Student Affairs considers that the student is absent from an acceptable excuse and is considered a rapporteur and does not count a year of failure.

B - The student is present in all the lectures that are absent because of his participation in the activities of the College and the University and the competitions of the official international sports federations and camps organized after an offer to prove that the aggressor.

Article (12) - Written, oral and applied examinations:

A - The examinations of the first and second semester in the courses taught by the student in his / her class shall be carried out. B. The student will move from the restricted group to the higher division if he succeeds in all the courses or if he fails in no more than two courses from his group or a lower class. In which he dropped courses in the role of February (defaults).

**C) A student who has failed in more than two courses from his or her)
group or a lower group remains to be returned in the course of the courses.**

D. Students enrolled and licensed to take the exam from abroad are subject to the disciplinary system described in the executive regulations of the Law of Organizing Universities No. (29) for the year 1972.

E) Students who are backward in one or two subjects or the examiner from abroad shall be re-examined in the oral, practical and editorial parts and shall increase the degree of work of the year to the student in the course to the equivalent of (50%) unless higher than that.

F- The English language is not considered a waste material when the student is transferred to the higher class. The student may not be granted a bachelor's degree until after passing her examinations successfully.

**G) The exam of the students who fail in the final group shall be held in)
no more than two courses in September (the role of September) in addition to the English language if the student is a student.**

H - A student who misses any of the written or applied examination does not have a degree in the course and is considered a teacher.

Article (13): Estimates for Bachelor's Degree:

Excellent 85% or more of all degrees

Very good 75% to less than 85% of the total score

Good 65% to less than 75% of all grades

Acceptable 50% to less than 65% of the total score

The student's failure is estimated as follows:

Poor 30% to less than 50% of the total score

Very poor less than 30% of the total score

The student is awarded the rank of honor if his general assessment is excellent or very good, provided that the general assessment in any of the academic teams is not very good and that he should not be absent in any examination offered in any school year.

The student is considered successful at the end of the year. He obtained at least 50% of the total number of theoretical, practical and practical subjects provided that he obtained 30% of the written examination in the theoretical subjects and 30% of the written and applied examination in the subjects Applied.

Article (14) Transitional provisions:

The provisions of these regulations shall apply to the beginning of the academic year following the approval of the Minister of Higher Education for approval of the new students in the faculty, the first class retractors of the bachelor's degree, and the rest of the students shall be subject to the provisions of the old regulations until they graduate.

The cases that appear in the application of this regulation and are not mentioned in these provisions shall be presented to the College Council for decision

**in accordance with the Law of Organizing Egyptian
Universities.**
